CODE OF CONDUCT FOR JUNIOR PLAYERS

As a member you are expected to abide by the following junior club rules.

All members must play within the spirit of the game, the rules of the competition and respect all officials and their decisions.

The Umpire's decision must be accepted at all times and no show of dissent or disagreement is to be made.

There must be no discrimination or bullying of anyone concerned.

Members should keep to agreed timings for training and fixtures and inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.

Members must abide by 'Safety guidance on the Wearing of Helmets and faceguards by Young Players'

Members must pay any annual subscriptions and fees for training and matches promptly.

Junior members are not allowed to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club.

Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.

Bad language will not be tolerated.

Any player disrupting coaching sessions will be asked to sit out. Parents will be informed if the disruption continues.

All players must assist the coaches and managers by returning all kit to the pavilion after matches and training, before leaving the ground.

Kit marked with Canon Frome CC, is the property of the club and must be stored in the pavilion. All balls must be returned after training
