CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS

Encourage your child to learn the rules and play within them.

Discourage unfair play and arguing with officials

Support and help team managers and appointed volunteers: avoid question or criticism of their judgement in public.

Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results.

Never force your child to take part in sport.

Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding the good performances of all.

Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes.

Publicly accept officials' judgements

Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their sport.

Use correct and proper language at all times.

Parents are reminded that helmets must be worn for all hardball cricket matches and net practice. This applies to all under 18's who are batting and / or wicket keeping whilst standing up to the stumps.

Do not leave children before 6pm on practice nights and ensure they are picked up promptly.

Parents must ensure that lifts are arranged to away fixtures before leaving a child at the meeting point.

Use of the nets by children outside designated coaching sessions is the responsibility of the parents.
