#### Training Received

I hold an enhanced CRB (Criminal Records Bureau) check.

In June 2004 I attended a 'Good Practice and Child Protection' course, which was updated as 'Safeguarding and Protecting Children' in 2008

In March 2005 I attended a 'Safe Hands Welfare of Young People in Cricket' course that also incorporated NSPCC 'Time to Listen'. Repeated April 2008.

#### Role:

1. To be the first point of contact for coaches, volunteers, parents and children / young people where concerns about children's welfare, poor practice or protection arise.
2. Implement the 'Welfare of Young People in Cricket' policy within Canon Frome CC.
3. Be a Club committee member.
4. Promote the organisation's best practice guidelines / codes of conduct within the club.
5. Raise awareness of child protection and ensure everyone in the club is aware of what training is available and work within the committee to ensure training requirements are met.
6. Keep confidential records of CRB checks and Self Declaration forms.
7. Keep a record of all disclosures.
8. Understand local procedures for reporting Child protection concerns to the statutory authorities.
9. Liaise with the County Welfare Officer
10. Support the interests of all children within cricket.
11. Keep records of all courses attended by club members and arrange updates.
